Have you ever done a leadership course and not implemented the ideas? That is not the case on the apprenticeship leadership programmes.

What is involved

- One full day workshop every month
- Coaching from your facilitator, once a month (one-to-one or group)
- Online collaborative learning platform
- Part of a learning community
- Commit to six hours of learning a week

If you pay the Apprenticeship Levy (ie, you have over £3 million of payroll), it is paid for out of the levy. If not, it is 95% funded by the government. So you would pay only £700 for a full two year senior leaders programme.
